Elmer Borough Land Use Board Minutes of Board Meeting Wednesday, June 6th, 2012

Walter Voeckler is in the process of still cleaning some debris from the property and anticipates erecting a garage on the property in the future. Secretary Dawn Williams will request a final inspection from the Zoning Officer John Leech. No action was taken.
