Elmer Borough Land Use Board Minutes of Board Meeting Thursday, September 5th, 2013

The regular meeting of the Elmer Borough Land Use Board was held on Thursday, September 5th, 2013 at 7:30 p.m. in the Elmer Borough Hall.
