NOTICE TO ALL PET OWNERS – The State of NJ requires that all rabies shots be good through November 1 of the license year. This year's **FREE** Rabies Clinic is on **Saturday, November 5, 2016 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM at the Elmer Fire Hall.** (NO LICENSES WILL BE ISSUED AT THIS TIME, IT IS ONLY A FREE RABIES CLINIC). If your pet's rabies shot expires prior to <u>11/01/2017</u> you will need to get a new rabies shot before you can get a new pet license. Deadline for the 2017 license is 03/31/2017. After that there is a **\$20** <u>per pet</u> late fee and possible additional court fines if you pay after 03/31/2017. Please check your pet's rabies information now to avoid these additional charges. It is preferred that all payments be mailed into the Elmer Borough (PO Box 882) or dropped in the drop box (at the bottom of the glass doors on the library side of the building). STORMWATER POLLUTION AND WHAT WE CAN DO ABOUT IT.

Water from rain and melting snow that flows over lawns, parking lots and streets is known as stormwater runoff. This water, which travels along gutters, into catch basins and through storm drain pipes and ditches, usually is not treated, but then flows or is discharged into local water bodies. Along the way, the storm water picks up trash (fast-food wrappers, cigarette butts, styrofoam cups, etc) and toxins and other pollutants (gas, motor oil, antifreeze, fertilizers, pesticides and pet droppings). This polluted stormwater can kill fish and other wildlife, destroy wildlife habitat, contaminate drinking water sources and force the closing of beaches because of health threats to swimmers.

Human activity is largely responsible for the stormwater pollution.

Everything that we put on the ground or into the storm drain can end up in our water.

Each of us has a responsibility to make sure these contaminants stay out of our water.

Whether we have clean water is up to you.

Mayor and Borough Council have recently updated Ordinances related to Property Maintenance and Sidewalk Maintenance.

In the upcoming months both of these Ordinances will be enforced by our Property Maintenance Officer.

Take special note that Chapter 20 4.3 CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENT OF SIDEWALKS was recently amended at the May 2016 Council Meeting. The Property Maintenance Officer will be inspecting and enforcing these code violations from the Borough Code Book and the International Property Maintenance Code Book, which regulates minimum maintenance requirements for existing buildings and structures. I want to assure our residents that these violations are not brought about to bother or harass homeowners or businesses. By enforcing these Ordinances we set a certain standard of property maintenance that is fair to everyone in our community.
