WHEREAS, in order for there to be consistency and no confusion over fees the Borough Council found it necessary to amend the fees table established in Chapter 2-71.1; and

WHEREAS, in order to amend the fee table, it is necessary for there to be a revision to the Elmer Borough Code through an adoption of an appropriate ordinance to effectuate the changes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Elmer as follows:

SECTION 1: §2-71.1a Fees, of the Borough of Elmer shall be deleted in its entirely.

SECTION 2: §2-71.1a Fees, of the Borough of Elmer shall read as follows:

Any payments for certified copies of vital records obtained as a result

Fees for vital records issued after the advertised office hours shall be	
increased by \$5 for each certified copy.	
Phone calls made to effect corrections in vital records	\$5 each
